



Itinerary:

Day 1: Síringet House - Arusha, Tanzanía.

- Arrive at Siringet House, set in the grounds of Kilimanjaro Golf and Wildlife Estate - a short 30 minute drive from Kilimanjaro International Airport
- · Wake up to stunning views of Kilimanjaro and Mount Meru









Day 4 and 5: Nomad's Entamanu Camp -Ngorongoro Crater Rím


- Wake up early and descend into the Crater Floor Be one
 of the first vehicles into the Crater; and enjoy an early
 morning coffee as the sun rises.
- Superb game viewing opportunities, including the chance to see Black Rhino. Game-drive until mid-day before returning to camp for lunch.





Highlights - Ngorongoro Crater - one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World

- This is the world's largest unbroken caldera and is home to between 25,000 and 40,000 large mammals at any one time.
- The crater is 12 miles (19 km) across in places and over 102 square miles (264 sq km) of wilderness.
- The rim of the crater rises over 2,000 feet (610 m) above the caldera floor reaching an elevation of 7,500 feet (2,286 m).



Highlights - Wildlife and People in Ngorongoro

- · The Crater Floor is undeniably an amazing place for wildlife viewing.
- But whilst the floor can be a busy place with other tourist vehicles, the Ngorongoro
 Conservation Area encompasses a much larger area, that was set up to protect both
 the wildlife and the livelihoods of the local Masai people and there is much to explore
 outside the Crater Floor that gets you away from this and interacting with the local
 people that live here.





Days 6, 7, 8 and 9 - Luxury Mobile Camp - Southern Serengeti



Highlights After a lovely breakfast watching the sunrise across the Ngorongoro Crater in the distance, set off in your Private 4x4 Land-Cruiser for the endless plains of the Serengeti. At this time of year, you will see the vast herds of wildebeest that have travelled south on their long migration to give birth on the rich volcanic soils that provide nourishment for the nursing mothers.

Highlights


- · Over 1.4 million wildebeest come to the Southern Serengeti Plains to give birth
- · January and February mark the birthing season, with as many as 8,000 calves being born a day during a 3-4 week period.




Highlights





